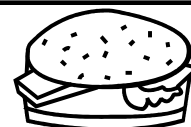


Orders For BBQ must be in school by 3:30pm on Monday 5th July

Programme:

- 1:15** Gates open and adults signed in and given sticker which is to be worn at all times stating which child they are with.
- 1:15 – 2:30** Classroom activities for Maths, Literacy, Science and DT for children and adults to do together.
- 2:00 Onwards** Refreshments available in the Breakfast Room – All profits in aid of the Air Ambulance Fund.
- 2:30 – 3:20** St Peter's Showcase outside under the canopy – A selection of singing, Dancing and other performances.
- 3:30 – 5:30** "Open Classrooms" an opportunity to see work and displays in school, BBQ (**to be pre booked with time allocations**), in school treasure hunt "Where is St Peter?" follow the clues and win a prize.
- 6:00 – 7:00** Awards Presentation Ceremony – Children receiving awards will receive individual letters inviting them and their parents/carers to this event in the hall. Awards will be made for good learners, good behaviour, achievement and progress, effort and perseverance. The church will award a cup for being helpful, caring and kind as well as other awards.
