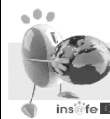

Cyberbullying is defined as
"the persistent use of IT,

particularly mobile phones and the internet, deliberately to upset someone else". It can take many forms including:

- Posting abusive messages online – on a social networking site, in a chatroom, or using IM
- Posting humiliating videos or pictures online, or sending them on to other people
- Taking on someone else's identity online in order to upset them
- Bad mouthing and spreading rumours
- Setting up hate site or a hate group on a website
- Prank calling, prank texts and messages
- Sending nasty or abusive messages
