Home Access is a Government Programme which will help ensure that more children will have access to technology at home to support their learning.

Who is eligible?

Low-income families across England, who meet set eligibility criteria, can now apply to a central body for a grant to purchase a computer and access to the internet to get on-line at home. The programme is aimed at those who need it most and is due to benefit more than 270,000 households by March 2011.

How to apply
