### After school Dance Club

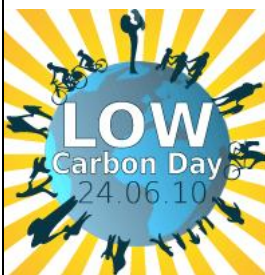
**Please note there will be no Dance Club, Latin or Ballroom classes on Tuesday 29th June but they will continue the following week as normal.**
