SEVEN STEPS

To be used in all lessons and by all staff

STEP 7 – EXCLUSION FROM SCHOOL
- either Short term

STEP 6
INTERNAL EXCLUSION
Removed from Class
NO playtimes while out of class

STEP 5
RED BEHAVIOUR CARD for 2 weeks
Playtimes lost and Parents seen.

STEP 4
Sent out of classroom with slip explaining why to Head and work at "corridor work Station" and given **WHITE Weekly Behaviour Card**

STEP 3
"Cross" next to name – Work given to do outside in playground at playtime and 5minutes off "GOLDEN TIME"

STEP 2
Pupil's name put on the "SAD Board" at front of the room

STEP 1
Verbal Warning / Yellow Warning Card placed on pupil's desk
